**KEY INDICATORS**



**97%** of 5th graders have a strong connection to school



**42%** of 7th graders reported being bullied in the past year



**88%** of 9th graders say they have a teacher or adult who really cares about them



**40%** of 11th graders have vaped or used e-cigarettes
